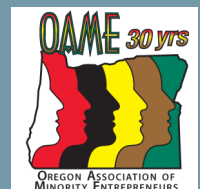

“OregonSaves Overview”

Joel Metten, Operations Manager, for the Oregon Savings Network, which includes the Oregon College Savings Plan, the Oregon ABLE Savings Plan, and the state’s new retirement savings program, OregonSaves. OregonSaves is for all workers who do not have a retirement savings option at work. It benefits employers, who won’t need to offer a retirement plan of their own if they don’t have the time or resources to set it up.

OregonSaves is a way for workers in Oregon to put away their own money for their retirement in their own Roth IRA accounts that go with them from one job to the next. This way you don’t have to worry about where your money is when you change jobs. The contributed amount is entirely up to the employee, every little bit will help once you hit retirement
